"Dr. Bob," 77, lost his 17 year battle with cancer and passed away peacefully at home in Dana Point, CA surrounded by family. Survived by his wife, Carol, sons Jeffrey and Jason, "daughter-in-love" Lisa, and his grandson Gavin (10), the "apple of his eye." Born in San Francisco, attended Cal Berkeley and Univ. of Arizona, College of Pharmacy, completing his education with a Ph.D. in pharmacology. Moved to Los Angeles where he met Carol, his beloved wife and soul mate of 50 years. Bob acquired retail pharmacies and a hospital pharmacy.

In 1981, Bob established Flying Horse Farm, a 244-acre thoroughbred racehorse breeding farm in Santa Ynez, CA. Bob enjoyed horseback riding, golf and traveling with Carol.

Bob served on the boards of Junior Guiders for Foundation for Junior Blind, Prostate Division for Cancer 411 and University Synagogue. Bob also leaves behind his favorite cousins Faye Eisenberg and Morley Meyerson, brother-in-law Bobby Blue, niece Jackie Duncan, and many close friends.

A memorial service will be held Oct. 2, 2011, 2:00 p.m. at University Synagogue in Irvine, CA.
