One of the greatest evangelists of the 20th century, Cleveland combined soul-winning with concern for social justice, pioneered the concept of national campaigns before satellite technology influenced gospel work globally. The first Adventist to baptize more than 1,000 people in a single campaign, Cleveland took every opportunity to enter the pulpit and inspire new generations.
