



Harold Chamberlin

January 25, 1928 - August 1, 2018

Harold “Hal” Gordon Chamberlin, the oldest of five (Jim, Jack, Joyce and Norm), was born on January 25, 1928 in Tonawanda New York to Arthur and Vera Chamberlin.

After graduating high school, he enlisted into the Navy on July 22, 1946. He was honorably discharged on July 21, 1950. He received the Good Conduct Medal and the World War II Victory Medal. He was stationed in Bainbridge Maryland, Jacksonville Florida, Ward Island Corpus Christie Texas and Memphis Tennessee. When asked about his service he was always adamant about being in Naval Air, not the Navy.

He then went to California where his family had moved to in 1948. He applied to and was hired into Douglas Aircraft Company in 1951 and retired in 1986. He went back as a contract hire for three more years. He was involved in commercial aircraft from the DC-9 to the MD-11. Also, military aircraft including the A4 and the C-17.

He loved classical music and opera. He sang opera in various choirs and with friends and was involved with charitable organizations like the Lions Club, which worked with the blind.

Hal died on August 1, 2018. He is survived by his first wife Janet and their

children Thomas, Richard, Cynthia and Andrew and his second wife Joan.

Funeral services will be at St Luke's Lutheran Church 2000 W. Valencia Drive, Fullerton, CA 92833 on Thursday August 16th @9am.
