July 11, 1916 - January 4, 2014

Ina J. Perry, longtime resident of Fullerton, passed away at her home of seventy years on Saturday, 4 January. She was 97 years old. Mrs. Perry, known as Granny to her family, was born in Baldwin, Arkansas on July 11, 1916 and married the late Earl W. Perry on November 19, 1937 in Fullerton. Ina and Earl Perry were the parents of three children (the late James E. Perry of Fullerton, Philip W. Perry of Orinda, California, and Susan D. Carl of Federal Way, Washington), five grandchildren, thirteen great-grandchildren, and stayed close to a loving network of cousins and friends around the United States. Ina spent a career in service with Pacific Bell, starting in the era of connecting people live ,“number please?” and retiring in the era of electronics.
