



## Leonard Lombardo

February 22, 1921 - May 8, 2017

Leonard L. Lombardo, age 96, died of natural causes on May 8, 2017, in Placentia, CA.

Leonard is survived by his three children, Lori, Lisa and Joey; his two son-in-laws; Paul and Dave and his two grand-children; Malachi, married to Alyssa and Mary. He is preceded in death by all of his siblings; Laura, Phillip, Dominic, Rose and Vincent.

Leonard was born on February 22, 1921 in Jamestown, NY, to parents Joseph and Josephine (Gaeta) Lombardo. He graduated from Falconer High School in 1939. He served in the Army Air Corp during World War II rising to Staff Sergeant. He moved out to CA after the war, and worked as a bartender, produce/grocer, air-conditioning installer and owned his own produce business. He settled in Anaheim, CA, with his wife, Geri and three children. They divorced in 1974, but Leonard was always close by to his children.

Leonard loved to make people laugh, made sure people were noticed and greeted, and enjoyed fine dining with family and friends. He was a great cook with simple, yet delicious taste.

He was a hard worker and was known to go out of his way to help a friend in need. His most memorable words to his children were, "Do you need anything?" (and if your driving, make sure you are in your car!)

There will be a small memorial service for him at Riverside Veterans Cemetery mid March, 2018.

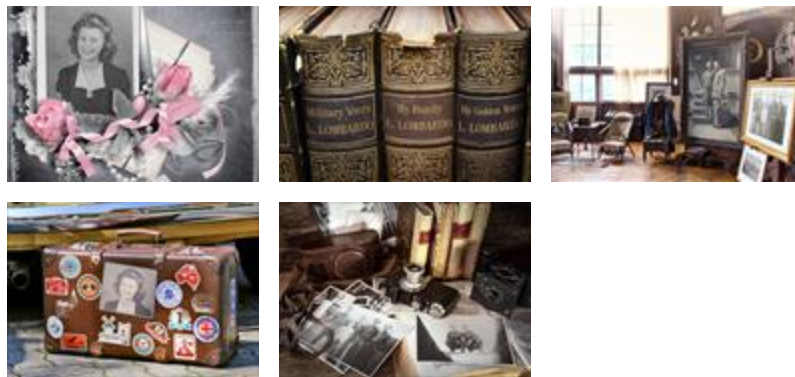

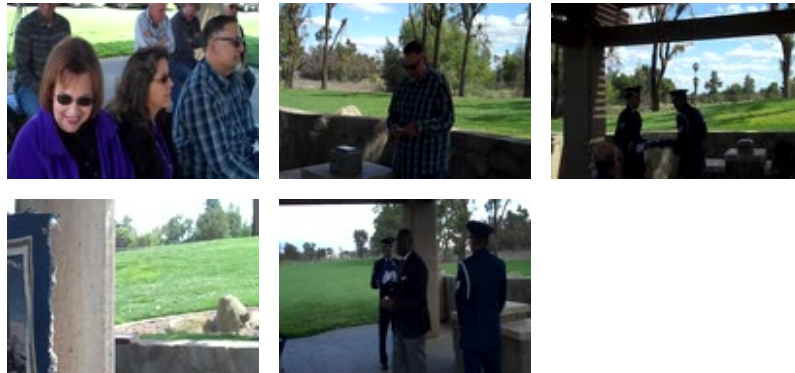
